Instructions for Lactation Room Usage at Macomb Community College

Welcome to the lactation room at Macomb Community College! This space is designed to provide a comfortable, private, and clean environment for students and employees who are nursing and/or pumping. Please follow these guidelines to ensure a positive experience for all users.

Accessing the Room:

Lactation Rooms are located at the following places:

- o Center Campus: J-Building, F-Building, and the University Center-2
- o South Campus: Library/J-Building and the Student Community Center/K-Building
- M-TEC and East Campuses: Contact the Title IX Coordinator for a designated space.

The room is accessible from 8 AM to 8 PM, Monday through Friday.

To gain access, check the lock to make sure it is not occupied, and enter the room.

Room Usage Guidelines:

Always keep the room clean. Wipe down surfaces before and after use with the provided cleaning supplies.

Ensure the door is fully closed and locked while using the room.

Respect the suggested time limit of 30 minutes to ensure fair access for all.

To maintain a sanitary environment, do not eat or drink in the room.

Equipment and Supplies:

The room is equipped with comfortable seating, a table, a sink, and electrical outlets. Cleaning supplies, such as disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer, are provided.

Storage and Personal Items:

Do not leave personal items or breast pumps in the room. Ensure all personal belongings are taken with you after each use.
